Southern University System Presidential Search Committee to hold second meeting in New Orleans

Baton Rouge, LA- Southern University's Presidential Search Committee has scheduled its next community forum on the Southern University at New Orleans campus. This meeting is the second in a series of open meetings, with a goal of receiving input from the campus communities on selecting the System's next President.

This meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday, September 16, 2009 at 5:30 pm** in the Knight's Café on the campus of Southern University at New Orleans (located at 6400 Press Drive). The purpose of the Open Forum is to allow Southern University at New Orleans administrators, faculty, staff, students, alumni, and community stakeholders an opportunity to voice concerns and/or offer to the Committee their comments, suggestions, and recommendations relating to the Presidential Search.

Speakers will be allowed 3 to 5 minutes (the maximum time allocated will depend upon the number of persons who indicate their intent to address the body prior to the meeting). The selected candidate will serve as the chief executive officer of the nation's only Historically Black University System~ the Southern University System, which is composed of five campuses: Southern University at Baton Rouge, Southern University at New Orleans, Southern University at Shreveport, Southern University Law Center, and the Southern University Ag Center.
